1. Past Kimberly Graduate - Application Criteria: The application will be evaluated based on student activities since graduating from Kimberly High School, work or student success since graduation and a description of financial need in the application.
2. Financial Need - Application Criteria: The application will be evaluated based on student financial need as described in the application.
3. Academic Performance - Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated strictly upon the combination of their Kimberly High School GPA and ACT, or SAT scores.
4. Career Technical Education Scholarship - Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated based on his/her description of the desire to study a chosen technical career. Grades and test scores will be part of the evaluation.
5. Unique Challenge Scholarship - Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated based on the written scholarship application detailing how the applicant will overcome the challenges they face in order to achieve their educational goals. Recommendation of the high school counselor or high school teacher must be included with the application.
6. Education Major - Application Criteria: The application will be evaluated based on the stated education major, the steps the applicant has done to prepare to become a professional educator, and grades/test scores.
7. Kimberly Lions Club Community Service Scholarship - Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated based on sustained community service as described in their application.

8. Champlin Ag Scholarship - Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated based on their chosen agriculture major, ag-related and service activities, career plans involving agriculture, and grade/test scores.

9. Leslie Ann Quesnell Schroeder Scholarship - Application Criteria: The applicant must be a single mother, have attended Kimberly schools, and may or may not have graduated. The applicant will be evaluated based upon the circumstances described in the application.

10. Zions Bank Scholarship - Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated on their chosen business major, business-related and service activities, career plans involving the field of business, and grades/test scores.

11. Deed Proprieties Scholarship-Application Criteria: The applicant will be evaluated on their chosen business major, service activities, involvement in school activities, career plans involving the field of business, and grades/test scores.
