11-2 2<sup>ND</sup> READING REVISE POLICY 2335 HEATH ENHANCEMENT

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The Kimberly School District has updated Policy 2335 – Health Enhancement using the ISBA Model Policy as a guide, ensuring compliance with recent Idaho law and state requirements. The revisions reflect changes in parental consent requirements and instructional content for health, family life, and sex education.

## Key Updates Include:

- 1. Parental Permission and Notification:
  - a. Before a student may participate in any sex education instruction, parents/guardians must receive at least two weeks' notice and the opportunity to review all instructional materials.
  - b. Parents must provide written permission for their student to participate. Students without permission will receive alternative educational activities.
  - c. If parents believe instruction occurred without permission, they may follow Procedure 2335P to file a complaint.

- 2. Comprehensive Sex Education Content:
  - a. Instruction covers abstinence, human sexuality, STIs, contraception, adoption, and general human sexuality.
  - b. Content includes topics required by law such as sexual conduct, sexual violence, sexual orientation, gender identity, and deviant sexual behavior.
  - c. Instruction in grades 5–12 on human biology, contraception, or STIs must include a computer-generated fetal development video showing all stages of development in the uterus. Parents must have the opportunity to review and provide permission before viewing.
