# FA comparison 2023-2024 to 2025-2026

| Semester | 2023-2024 (599 students) | 2024-2025 (654 students) | 2025-2026 (641 students) | Avg.  |
|----------|--------------------------|--------------------------|--------------------------|-------|
| S1       | 81 students (13.5%)      | 91 students (13.9%)      | 109 students (17%)       | 14.8% |
| S2       | 126 students (21%)       | 141 students (21.6%)     | *105 students (16.3%)    | 19.6% |

FA status is when a student has missed more than 10% of a class. This is also referred to as being chronically absent.

Students must make up seat time during lunch, after school, during a work release period, or attend Saturday school.

# Excessive tardy comparison 2024-2025 to 2025-2026

| Semester | 2024-2025 (654 students) | 2025-2026 (641 students) | Avg.  |
|----------|--------------------------|--------------------------|-------|
| S1       | 102 students (15.6%)     | 99 students (15.4%)      | 15.5% |
| S2       | 115 students (17.6%)     | *104 students (16.2%)    | 16.9% |

A student is considered to have excessive tardies when they have at least 4 unexcused tardies in a class. Students must serve detention during lunch, after school, or during a work release. When a student reaches 10 unexcused tardies in a class, they must serve 1-day of ISS.

In the first semester, 14 students served ISS.

In the second semester, 9 students served ISS so far.
