

Dear Kimberly School District Patrons,

Kimberly School District recognizes that youth activities and community use of facilities have evolved, with families and patrons now participating in a wider variety of programs and organizations. In response, the District is working to ensure our facilities can accommodate these changing needs. This effort aligns with the Board's goal of increasing community use of district facilities by 10%.

As part of this work, the District is reviewing and refining its facility use and scheduling practices for Kimberly-based groups. Our focus is to create a system that is clear, consistent, and responsive to the needs of the broader community.

The District's expectation is that Kimberly-based organizations and teams will have equitable access to district facilities. Community use will continue to be supported at no cost whenever it can be accommodated within existing staff duty structures. Fees will only be considered in situations where use results in extraordinary costs, such as additional staffing time or supplies beyond normal operations.

Organizations or groups not based in Kimberly will continue to be assessed facility use fees in accordance with District practices.

As scheduling practices are updated, reasonable and balanced access for youth and community groups will remain a priority.

These efforts are important regardless of future facility expansion. While additional space may provide greater flexibility, the District is committed to improving access and clarity within current resources.

Kimberly School District remains committed to being a strong community partner and will continue working toward a facility use model that is welcoming, transparent, and supportive of all patrons.
