KIMBERLY SCHOOL DISTRICT: Proposal—K-3

The data we received this go-round indicates interest from the community for grades K-3 at RISE Charter School. We received a total of 109 responses in just 13 days.

- a. 44 asked for more information about RISE; 39 gave contact information
- b. 4 wanted more information but left no contact info
- c. Of the 44 interested, 19 have multiple children in grades K-3 = 51 children
- d. Seven have current siblings at RISE

I believe that we will have enough interest to fill all grades K-3 that are authorized by the Kimberly School District for year 2024-25.

- Emailed all contacts a summary of the most frequently asked questions and answers along with some background information about our school.
- Contacted 14 parents via phone of which 11 said they would like to enroll child in lottery; the 3 others did not have a student in those grades. I
 - Most wanted to know about the curriculum or model we would use and wanted to know where the younger grades would be located.
 - One parent on social media commented that they did not want to make a commitment until they knew what curriculum would be used.
 - One said they hoped they would not have to wait until fourth grade to transfer their student to RISE as that would be a more difficult transition.
 - I also received questions about logistics such as bussing, breakfast/lunch, and if older students would be separated from younger students, and where classes will be held.
