2nd Reading Policy 3360 – Extracurricular Transportation Student Fee Policy

The Board has previously discussed the increasing cost of providing transportation for extracurricular activities. State transportation funding does not reimburse the district for extracurricular transportation costs. Currently, the district utilizes Supplemental Levy funds for non-reimbursable transportation expenses, with the remaining costs being paid from the General Fund. The purpose of Policy 3360 – Extracurricular Transportation Student Fee Policy is to establish a framework for recovering a portion of the transportation costs currently being paid from the General Fund while continuing to have the district cover the remaining costs.

Administration is requesting that the Board review the proposed Policy 3360 and provide direction on the proposed fee amounts that would be established under the policy. Because the policy would authorize the imposition of a new fee, Idaho Code § 63-1311A requires the Board to hold a public hearing and provide the required public notice before the fee may be adopted.

If the Board wishes to move forward with Policy 3360, the recommended action at this meeting is to:

1. Provide direction on the proposed extracurricular transportation fee amounts to be presented to the public; and
2. Set the required public hearing for the Board's regular meeting on August 20, 2026. Following the public hearing, the Board may consider adopting the fee authorized under Policy 3360.
