


Number of students who received a refocus is down. Most behaviors occurring around lunch time. Disrespect and minor physical contact tops the list.





Number of students with **no** "refocuses" is up to 90.97%.


Number of students who received a refocus is down. Most behaviors occurring during lunch, followed by last recess. Minor disruptions are the most frequently reported issue.




Number of students with **no** behavior logs is up to 92.20%.



Most behaviors occur during the lunch break, followed by disruptions and disrespect in fourth hour.




