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Library Checkout Form

Students checking out materials from a Kimberly School library or classroom collection must have parental consent on file if under 18. Students will receive one of three designations:

- Full Access: Students can check out any materials found in the school library or classroom collections, including books on the Restricted List¹.
- General Access: Students can checkout only materials in general circulation (Not on the Restricted List). Books in general circulation deemed unsuitable for individual family reasons by parents as will be returned.
- No Access: Student does not have parental permission to checkout materials from the library. Parents designating their student as “no access” accept the responsibility to provide their students with acceptable books that fulfill class requirements (Quarterly AR assignments, projects, etc).

Students at the KHS are issued a student ID card at no charge, and this shall double as a library card with their library status included. Students are responsible for providing their ID card to checkout materials. Students that have lost their ID card will need to acquire a replacement from the office for \$2.00 before they can checkout materials.
