- ISTATION IS A COMPUTER-ADAPTIVE LITERACY FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT TOOL (ISIP)
- IT IDENTIFIES STUDENTS WHO ARE AT RISK FOR PROBLEMS IN LEARNING TO READ, AND IT PROVIDES APPROPRIATE INSTRUCTION TO ENSURE THEIR READING SUCCESS.
- PLACES STUDENTS ON PERSONALIZED INSTRUCTIONAL PATHS UNIQUE TO THEIR NEEDS

- THE STATE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES IRI/ISIP TESTING FOR GRADES K-3 IN THE FALL AND IN THE SPRING.
- OUR SCHOOLS USE IT K-5 FOR ONCE-A-MONTH TESTING TO IDENTIFY STUDENTS THAT ARE NEEDING ASSISTANCE IN THE AREA OF READING.

- STUDENTS SCORING IN TIER 1 (BELOW GRADE LEVEL) ARE REQUIRED TO BE OFFERED 60 HOURS OF LITERACY INTERVENTION
- STUDENTS SCORING IN TIER 2 (NEAR GRADE LEVEL) ARE REQUIRED TO BE OFFERED 40 HOURS OF LITERACY INTERVENTION
- STUDENTS IN TIER 3-5 ARE AT GRADE LEVEL
