### Summary of the grade count and GPA data

- The grade count has improved over the last 3 semesters from 87% to 88% to 90% of grades are a C or higher.
- GPA's have remained steady in the 4.0, 3.0 or higher, and 2.0 or higher ranges.
- The cell phone policy has improved the classroom environment.
  - Teachers have reported more time is being used in class to complete assignments.

### Failure by attendance hours (FA)


FA status is reached by exceeding 5 absences in a block class or 10 absences for an everyday class (zero hour) during a semester.


- 95 students (16%) reached FA status in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester
- 527 hours of detention was served to clear FA status
- Only 1 student did not serve any time and received an FA grade in 2 classes


### Class of 2024 graduation progress

#### **SENIORS:**

- 1 senior is off-track and will not graduate with the Class of 2024.
- 3 juniors will graduate early with the Class of 2024.
- 2 seniors completed high school requirements early and are attending college full-time this semester (CSI and BSU).
- We are on track for a graduation rate of 99%

### Behavior incidents

- Last year, KHS logged 683 behavior incidents
- This year, KHS has logged 327 incidents through January 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- We are on pace for approximately 650 incidents this year.
