

- C. One-page academic resume—Please include your name, address, and phone number as well as the name, address and phone number of your parent or guardian and your community service, extracurricular activities, work experience, scholastic honors or awards and any other honors or awards.
- D. Copy of your transcripts
- **E.** Personal Financial Information—List other scholarships you have received and your personal plan for financing your education including your personal savings.
- **F.** Choose one or more scholarship(s) listed below and submit a paragraph (maximum of 100 words per scholarship paragraph) addressing any additional information that you have not already shared regarding the specific scholarship(s).
