Supplemental Levy 2022

A Focus Group of Community Member met on December 13th – members included: Business Owners, Retirees, Parents of KSD students, Community members with no students in KSD schools.

- Recommendation:
- Pass resolution for \$800,000 supplemental levy for the March election.

The current levy of \$800,000 expires on July 1, 2022. The proposed levy will <u>replace</u> the current levy.

Prior to 2020, the combined supplemental and emergency levy was \$450,000. We have not had an emergency levy in the past 2 years.

Goals for the prior supplemental Levy:

1. Replace supplemental (\$250,000) and emergency (\$202,968) levies.

2. Reduce deficit spending and increase contingency reserve:

Net Change in Beginning Balances:

- FY21: \$371,757
- FY20: \$303,827
- FY19: (\$64,474)
- FY18: (\$202,118)
- FY17: (\$ 53,308
- 3. Reduce Class Sizes

Contingency Reserve: (cash balance on June 30th)

- FY21: \$1,487,444 (\$750,000 Restricted Reserve)
- FY20: \$1,115,687 (\$750,000 Restricted Reserve)
- FY19: \$ 811,858 (\$149,852 Restricted Reserve)
- FY18: \$ 873,332 (\$149,852 Restricted Reserve)
- FY17: \$1,075,451 (\$156,242 Restricted Reserve) Average month expenses: \$1.1M. Auditor recommends a 90-day reserve.

- Core Classes Only

Recommendation: \$800,000 for 2022-2024

Supplemental Levy of \$800,000 (maintains current services and class sizes): \$0 net increase in total levy:

 \$109 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value per year. If the \$800,000 supplemental levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 is not expected to change.

Historical Property Tax Levy Rates


The following is a 10-year comparison of the District's total property tax rates.
