Terms And Conditions

- 1) Idaho Child Nutrition Programs has received funding through the Supply Chain Assistance (SCA) to alleviate supply chain disruptions in the school meal programs. The Supply Chain Assistance funds support procurement of agricultural commodities grown in the US and enable USDA's Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) and Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) to enhance the toolbox for school nutrition professionals working hard to make sure students have access to healthy meals. The Idaho legislature has authorized funding are being distributed with the Grant Reimbursement Application (GRA).

Although receipts will not be needed to claim the funds, they must be kept on file to document procurements and be made available during an audit/review to show that the funds were spent in accordance with regulations.

By submitting a request for funds through the GRA you agree to the following:

- My district is experiencing Supply Chain disruptions.
- My district will only use funds to purchase domestic unprocessed or minimally processed foods.
- My district will not use funds for any labor, indirect, or other administrative expenses.
- My district will comply with all recordkeeping and review requirements per 7 CFR 210.9(b)(17) and 7 CFR 210.18, which would include maintaining documentation demonstrating appropriate use of SCA funds.
- My district will comply with all applicable Federal procurement and financial management requirements per 2 CFR 200.
- All funds must go into the Child Nutrition Fund 290 account AND funds can only be used for purchases from the date of disbursement forward.
