## **Covid Community Spread Assessment Team:**

The assessment team will convene on Fridays to determine the minimum "color stage" for days 7-14 from the next two weeks from the meeting date to allow staff and patrons to plan accordingly. Movement from one risk level to a lesser risk level will occur in 7-14 day intervals whereas moving to a more restrictive risk level may occur suddenly dependent upon the infection rate within the community or school district. In the event there is a sudden spike in community spread, outbreak in the district, etc. the Covid Assessment Team will meet immediately to evaluate the color stage. The assessment team will utilize SCHD ratings, county infection and positive testing rates, school district infection rates, etc. when determining the color stage. Team members will consist of board chair, superintendent, school nurses, SCDH representative, and two Magic Valley health providers. that is not a patron of Kimberly School District. Members will be determined by the board chair and superintendent.
