### SPECIAL EDUCATION



- Enrollment = 174 (+5)
  - PK = 20 (+2)
  - Elem = 67 (+2)
  - KMS = 46 (+3)
  - KHS = 41 (-2)
- Enrollment for special education has increased every year since 2014-15. Numbers are based on Nov Child Count (2019-20 based on current enrolment).

 We are not seeing consistent trends of improvement for ELA and Math proficiency with our sped population. This an area we need to focus on for continuous improvement. We are currently working on obtaining research based curriculum for our special education program. We will also need to provide ongoing training for gen ed and sped teachers in regard to instructional practices and data based decision making.



- We continue to see an increase in behavioral needs of students. We are working with SESTA to provide consultation and training in this area.
- JB and Keelie attended special education law training in Boise last week. The training was extremely valuable and we received great resource which we have shared with staff. We will incorporate the training into our monthly collaboration meetings.

  - Elem = 48 (+12), LEP 1 = 9 (-3)
  - KMS = 26 (+3), LEP1 = 0
  - KHS = 14 (+1), LEP 1 =0
- Marygrace and Cathy continue to work with our secondary schools to build an ELL program and ensure services are being provided. The challenges faced by teachers include determining and implementing interventions, limited staff to serve ELL students, and finding ways to increase the reading level of ELL students. Teachers are focusing on instructional strategies and modifications to meet the needs of our ELL students.

### MIGRANT: Thelma Cruz

- Enrollment = 59 (+14)
  - KES = 29 (+7)
  - KMS = 14 (+4)
  - KHS = 14 (+3)
- Thelma continues to do an amazing job identifying and working with our migrant families. She works with them to access both school and community resources. She has developed relationships of trust with the families and has made a tremendous impact on our migrant program.
- Migrant training will be provided to staff in Nov.

#### HOMELESS:

  - PK = 1
  - Elem = 3
  - KMS = 3
  - KHS = 1
