Brief description of history/motivation with Mastery Education. Our principal Justin White, as well as multiple teachers within

our high school, have expressed interest in mastery-based education being implemented in our curriculum. Several of our students through specialized education programs have been able to demonstrate success on mastery-based learning models, and many teachers are interested in implementation of the model within General Ed classrooms. We have teachers comprising all four cores, as well as our business department, and many other teachers look forward to aligning online classrooms with a standard mastery model.
