# Project AWARE State Education Agency Grant

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Purpose:

To build or expand the capacity of State Educational Agencies, in partnership with State Mental Health Agencies overseeing school-aged youth, with three local education agencies, to:

1. Increase awareness of mental health issues among school-aged youth;
2. Provide training for school personnel and other adults who interact with school-aged youth to detect and respond to mental health issues; and
3. Connect school-aged youth, who may have behavioral health issues, and their families to needed services.

# The Goals of ID-AWARE Project

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1. Increase the **capacity** of the LEAs to work preventatively, identifying and supporting students earlier before issues escalate
2. Link students' needs to appropriate **evidence-based** interventions
3. Create and sustain **data tracking systems** to ensure youth receiving intervention are showing improvement
4. Expand the work of **clinicians** to support adults as well as students across all tiers of support
5. Assist in creating **healthier school environments**
