- **Star testing** has been completed. This assessment will help determine student reading levels. Teachers, parents, and students use this data to help in book selection for independent and supported reading.



- ISIP testing has nearly been completed in grades k-3. (IRI)




ISIP[™] Early Reading results for Stricker Elementary

- We have purchased Read 180, a research-based curriculum for our secondary sped department.
