We are off to a great start to the second semester.

We have 123 students who are earning GPAs that qualify them for the opportunity to apply for membership in National Honor Society. Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors are invited to apply for NHS membership.

We have more opportunities for students to take classes to enhance their learning at Kimberly High School. This semester, we offer Psychology 101 and English 102 in the Round building taught by CSI professors, and Mr. Darrington is teaching English 101 and has 61 students taking it for dual credit. Students can obtain their GEM Certificate while on Kimberly HS campus or by attending classes at CSI, which is recognized across the Gem State for students who have completed 36 credits of general education courses at the college level. We work closely with CSI to help students realize this goal.

Our Speech and Debate team competed in the National Qualifying meet in Blackfoot, and we hope to have several qualify for Nationals. The Theatre class is busy preparing for their spring performance of “The Music Man” musical. There are sixty students involved in the production, and the performance will be at the Roper Auditorium on February 27, 28, 29th.
